Defense options over opponents' No Trump

D.O.N.T. (Disturb Opponent's No Trump)

The object is to stop your opponents from playing 1NT ...

- What do you need?
 - o 7 to 15 HCP and a "shapely" hand
 - At least 6 cards in one suit, or
 - At least 5/4 cards in two different suits
- D.O.N.T. (bid over opponents NT)
 - o "Double" I have a long suit (6 or more) somewhere
 - o 2C clubs and a higher suit (5 cards in one and 4 cards in the other)
 - o 2D clubs and a higher suit (5 cards in one and 4 cards in the other)
 - o 2H hearts and spades (5 cards in one and 4 cards in the other)
 - o 2S 6 or more spades with a very weak hand less than a double (i.e., 7+HCP)
 - 2NT 5/5 in the minors (clubs and diamonds)
- Responses to partner's D.O.N.T. bid
 - o OBJECT: Find an 8-card fit at the lowest level possible
 - Over partner's "Double"
 - 2C asks what is your long suit?
 - Partner (D.O.N.T. bidder) then bids their long suit
 - Partner will "pass" if their long suit is clubs
 - 2D, 2H or 2S says I have this good 6-card suit (w/only 0 or 1 club)
 - Over partner's 2C or 2D bid
 - 2NT shows a strong hand (15 HCP) with a 4-card major
 - partner will rebid their other suit
 - you hope to find an 8-card fit in a major
 - Pass; if you have 3 or 4 cards in partner's minor
 - If opponents "Double" partner's 2C or 2D bid
 - Pass to play partner's 2C* or 2D* bid
 - Redouble to rescue ask partner to bid their other suit

Cappelletti

Useful over strong or weak NT

- Cappelletti (bid over opponents NT)
 - o "Double" for penalties
 - o 2C I have a long suit (6 or more) somewhere
 - o 2D I have both majors (5 cards in one and 4 cards in the other)
 - o 2H hearts and a minor suit (5 cards in one and 4 cards in the other)
 - 2S spades and a minor suit (5 cards in one and 4 cards in the other)
 - 2NT 5/5 in the minors (clubs and diamonds)
- Responses to partner's Cappelletti bid, when partner bids ...
 - Double
 - Usually <u>Pass</u> for penalties (trust your partner)
 - Bid your long suit (6+ cards) only if you are extremely weak
 - o 2C
- Bid 2D; asking partner to bid their long suit
 - · Partner will pass if their suit is diamonds
- Pass; if you hold a good 6+ clubs
- Bid 2H/2S; if you hold a good 6+ cards in that major suit
- Bid 2NT; with 12+ points and a balanced hand inviting game
- \circ 2D
- Pass; if you hold a good 6+ diamonds and no 4-card major
- Bid 2H/2S; is to play
- Bid 3H/3S; invites partner to bid game in the major w/maximum
- Bid 2NT; asks partner for more information
 - Partner rebids 3H or 3S
 - o Shows 5/4 and a minimum hand
 - Partner rebids 4H or 4S
 - Shows 5/4 and a maximum hand
 - Partner rebids 3C
 - Shows 5/5 in the majors with a minimum hand
 - Partner rebids 4C
 - O Shows 5/5 in the majors with a maximum hand
- 2H or 2S
 - Pass; with 4 cards in that major and minimum hand
 - Raise that major with 4 cards in that major and maximum hand
 - Bid 2NT; asks partner to bid their minor suit
 - Shows both minors and no fit in partner's major
 - Requires slightly more HCPs since auction must go to 3-level
- 2NT
 - "Unusual NT" shows 5/5 in the minors
 - Requires slightly more HCPs since auction must go to 3-level

Bloomin

Keeps bidding over opponents NT at lower level Gives up the seldom useful penalty double

- Bloomin (bid over opponents NT)
 - o "Double" 5/4 in two suits
 - o 2C, 2D, 2H, or 2S shows a long (6+ cards) in that suit
 - o 2NT 5/5 in the minors (clubs and diamonds)
- Responses to partner's Bloomin bid, when partner bids ...
 - o Double
 - Requires a 2C bid
 - Partner response of 2D, 2H, 2S, or 2NT same as Cappelletti
 - 2D shows both majors
 - 2H shows hearts and an undisclosed minor
 - 2S shows spades and an undisclosed minor
 - 2NT shows 5/5 in the minors with more than minimum
